### Computing

### P.S.H.C.E

(Personal, Social, Health and Citizenship Education)

This term the children will explore mindfulness techniques. They will then discuss the importance of good sleep and ways that they can improve the quality of their sleep.

### Art/DT

In DT children will make a Viking longhouse on launch day.

In Art the children will explore light and colour in a range of famous works and produce light painting photography.

### History and Geography

Topic focus – The Vikings and Anglo-Saxons  
**Launch Activity – Design and make a Viking longhouse.**

We shall explore many aspects of Anglo-Saxon and Viking times including family life, invasions, arts and crafts, boats and religion. We will discuss how Vikings are viewed in the modern day world.

We shall explore settlements in Geography, looking at different types of settlement and how and why they have developed. We shall also explore place names.

### Languages

French work this term will focus on houses and homes. Children will then carry out a longer term project planning a holiday to a French speaking country.

### P.E

During the spring term each class will do Real PE, tennis and dance.

In the summer term tennis will continue and children will explore many skills and athletic events. All classes will have Forest School sessions this term. Children across the school will take part in Sports Day.

### Science

The classes will explore electricity and light. They will investigate how to change the number of cells in a circuit.

They will then look at the classification of living things.

### Music/Drama

Children will develop their music and drama skills in order to perform an End of Year production.
