



Behaviour Policy Appendix (ref COVID-19) May 2020

To protect the safety of staff and children when school reopens from June 1st, children will be following these simple rules.

- Follow new routines for arrival or departure (floor markings and posters).
- Follow school instructions on handwashing.
- Move around the school as your teacher tells you (for example, one-way systems, out of bounds areas, queuing).
- For older children: in the classroom stay 2m away from others by staying in your seat unless your teacher has told you otherwise.
- Follow the rule for 'catch it, bin it, kill it' and avoiding touching your mouth, nose and eyes with hands.
- Tell an adult if you are not feeling well.
- Follow the rules about sharing any equipment or other items.
- Keep to your allocated area during breaks or lunch times.
- Only one person at a time may use the toilets.

Younger children will be encouraged to adhere to these rules as best they are able and with guidance and support from staff.
