

## Home Schooling Weekly Outline

**Class/date: Evenlaode Summer Term 6 Week 4– wb 22<sup>nd</sup> June**

<b>English</b> 1 hour per day	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Daily BBC Bitesize lesson – containing reading, writing and SPaG:</b> <a href="https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize">https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize</a></li> <li>• <b>Monday</b>_ Watch El Camninate from 4.10 to the end. Make a timeline of events and plan the ending of the story. Stories often link back to the beginning of the story so remember this – e.g. El Caminante walks out through the archway</li> <li>• <b>Tuesday</b> – Complete the ending to the story and proof read the whole story for spelling and punctuation errors</li> <li>• <b>Wednesday – Reading</b> – Use a book of your choice. Find new vocabulary that you do not really know the meaning of and make a glossary of them with the meaning next to them. Use a dictionary to find out the definition of the words. Make up a word search or a crossword for this new vocabulary.</li> <li>• <b>Thursday – SPaG Proof reading and editing</b> – Read the proof reading passage (Hunger games - on Padlet) spotting and changing the spelling and punctuation errors. Then read and edit the El Caminante text (on Padlet). You could: improve some of the language, use a variety of sentence openers, add relative clauses, similes, sophisticated punctuation (e.g. semi colons, brackets, dashes).</li> <li>• <b>Friday – SPaG - Create an advertising poster for El Caminante.</b> How could you make the villagers want to go to the event? What information would they need to know? Think about how you will make your poster eye-catching yet informative. Use the persuasive language ideas on Padelt.</li> </ul>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Topic</b> 1 hour per day</p>	<p><b>In school</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Science- Mould experiment</li> <li>• PSHE – transition</li> <li>• PE – tennis and kick rounders</li> </ul> <p><b>At home</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Create a drawing of a memory from your time at Parton Manor, colouring it in. If possible, get another member of your family to film you sharing your memory- a paper plane flies in from the left of the screen, you open it and hold the picture of your memory up to the camera, say a sentence or two about the memory, fold it back up and throw it out to the right of the screen. If you can't get filmed at home, take your drawing into school and we will try to film it at some point in the week. <b>(Is it okay for them to bring it in- germs etc. or should they draw it in school as well?)</b></li> <li>• Choose a significant person (e.g. Nelson Mandela, Greta Thunberg, Rosa parks) research them and create an information sheet about that person and why they are important.</li> <li>• Research micro-organisms. Create a poster with what you have learnt.
