With the book you are currently reading, predict what might happen in the rest of the story. Write your prediction in the form of a comic strip. A blank template can be found on the padlet.</li> <li>• <b>Thursday &amp; Friday</b> – – Use the Poetry Terms PowerPoint to recap the features of poetry. Read the poem ‘Our Tiny Feet’ and then use it to find some of the features. Task is to write a poem about your time at Parton Manor. It does not have to rhyme but should use some of the features from the PowerPoint. Begin by using the planning sheet to write down all of your ideas. You might want to use a new blank planning sheet for each year you have attended the school. Or you might want to use a new blank planning sheet for each stanza of your poem. I have started an example one to show you. You could include school trips, forest school, performances, teachers, friends, lessons, responsibilities etc. After planning, write up your leavers poem. You may want to use the template on padlet.</li> </ul>
