In the event of a positive COVID test for a staff member or child:

The year group consisting of all children and the relevant staff will be asked to isolate for 10 days

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide opportunity for children to access video lessons at home • (Desk-tops/ laptops/ tablets are ideal. If there is an issue with providing these, please contact school who will do what they can to help) • Ensure children log-in to each lesson and complete follow-up work • Ensure work is uploaded to their child's Dojo portfolio • Phone school in the usual way if their child is ill • Unless ill, children are expected to log on to every session 	<p><u>On the first day of home learning the class teacher will:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Add a weekly home learning grid to the Class Dojo page • Post on Class Dojo the link to a Zoom meeting which will be the basis for future daily video lessons and inform parents of the times of the lessons <p><u>From the second day of home learning:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Video lessons via Zoom will begin • There will be 3 lessons each day lasting 10-20 minutes each depending on the age of the children • The lessons will primarily be English and Maths; other subjects will be covered by the home learning grid • The class teacher will set follow up work to be completed after the lesson. If there are worksheets or items to be downloaded they will be posted on the Class Dojo page • Class teachers will take a register each lesson • Teachers will provide feedback to work in the portfolios. This will be a general comment about the work uploaded not each individual piece of work
