<p><b>Maths</b> 1 hour per day</p>	<p><b>This week we will start a new unit on algebra.</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Live Maths Zoom lessons will take place at 9:15.</b></p> <p>All maths tasks will follow the White Rose scheme of work that we use in school. As a result, the children will be covering exactly the same themes at home as they would have been in school.</p> <p>Please ensure that children watch the video for each lesson first before they work on the sheets. The video covers what we would have presented in class as out teaching input. There is also a PowerPoint of some of the slides attached. When working on the sheets, the children can refer back to/watch again the video if there are things they are unsure about.</p> <p>The first page of each sheet includes questions that children should be able to complete having watched the video. The second page includes more problem solving questions and is meant to be more of a challenge.
