Reading regularly at home makes a huge difference

- Home Reader will be changed and sent home each week - please read this with your child 3 times a week - out on Mondays and back in on Fridays
- Children should be able to read these books with a 95% accuracy
- Please record in reading record home readers as well as other books they might read to you but please ensure they read their home reader 3 times
- Books in every morning with reading diary
- Certificates for reading 10, 25, 75 and 100 times and 25 times after
- ▶ 100 Reading badges

The shared book is for YOU to read:

Make the story sound as exciting as you can by changing your voice.

Talk with your child as much as you can:

- ➤ Introduce new and exciting language
- > Encourage your child to use new vocabulary
- Make up sentences together
- > Find different words to use
- Describe things you see

Swimming


- Thursday Swimming
